We are pleased to provide you with our registration form for the 2010 season.

Over the last 72 years, Camp Tékakwitha has acquired an enviable reputation by ensuring the continuity and the evolution of its educative mission. We offer children and teenagers a sound environment where the exceptional beauty of nature, interesting and varied activities and the strengths of human relationships contribute to their development. This unique approach complements the education that children get from their family and school environments.

All our staff and the vast majority of children being French-speaking, this is the perfect summer camp for your child to improve his fluency in French! However, our major concern being the wellbeing of all campers attending camp, we require that they possess a good knowledge of the French language in order to enjoy their stay (be assured that our staff will help if they have difficulties). Over the last few summers, we have welcomed children from New York, Florida, Illinois, Montana, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, California, Virginia, North Dakota, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Ohio and Maine as well as France, Switzerland, Holland, Belgium, The Equator and Columbia.

In addition to the Camper program for children from 8 to 12 and the "Explorateur" program for the 13 year olds, we also offer teenagers 14 to 16 years old, the Pioneer program. A unique hiking program on the Appalachian Trail, it represents a challenge like no other! You will find more information about this program on our website.

The Camp offers stays of 13 or 14 days for the 8 to 10 year olds and periods of four weeks for all. Based on years of experience and the numerous positive comments that we have received, we strongly believe that the 4-week session is a preferable option. Children have plenty of time to create strong friendships and to enjoy their favorite activities numerous times. Please note that minimal age for campers have been raised to 8 years old.

We will process registration forms beginning November 24<sup>h</sup> 2009 following these priority rules:

- 2009's campers and pioneer will have this priority up to december 20th 2009 if they are registering for the same period and group.
- After december 20th, priority will go to 2008 and 2009's campers independently of period and group they are registering for.
- After January 15th, registrations will be accepted without any priority for former campers

In order to constantly improve and maintain the quality of our activities, infrastructures and to help less fortunate children, Camp Tékakwitha (a non-profit organization) is accepting voluntary donations.

Charter
A charter bus is available from Quebec City and Montreal for \$90.00 \$CDN (one-way) (\$90,00 US). Transportation from the Portland Airport can also be arranged. The fee from the airport to the Camp is \$50.00 CDN (one-way) (\$50,00 US). The Portland Airport has direct connections with Boston and New York.
Insurance
For Canadian citizens, if your child is covered by your health insurance, it is important to fill the insurance section. If your child is not covered, an insurance fee will be ad to you account. The fees are 30,00\$ for two weeks and 55,00\$ for one month session. For other country campers, insurance information are mandatory.

## Passport

Owing to new requirement of the American government, if you are travelling from Canada or other country, it is mandatory to acquire a passport for your child before the beginning of season 2009. ## Refund policy

Pensions fees will be 100% reimbursed for cancellations made before May 15<sup>th</sup>. In the case of a cancellation made after May 15<sup>th</sup> or before the end of the session, the Camp will reimburse the smallest amount of the following: 50% of the pension fee or fee equivalent to the unused days of the session. However there will be no refund in case of dismissal for misbehaviour (loneliness, pre-existing medical conditions, drugs, harassment, violence, vandalism etc... ) and for reasons considered unjustified by Camp Officials.

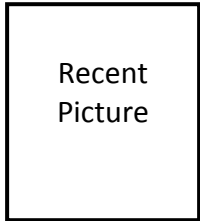
